The most recent phase of the remedial road works required to the new School Road roundabout has now completed. We apologise that the traffic lights were in use for longer than originally communicated, however this has enabled the works to be completed two weeks ahead of programme. The final phase of the kerb works will take place early next year.

MUJV Works


MUJV will install a foul sewage pipe that crosses the Packway. This work will take place between 19 and 23 Nov 18.


Section 278 Works

The main Section 278 work is to create a right hand turning lane into the Ross Road entrance of Larkhill Garrison. This involves widening the road and installing all the necessary drainage, kerbing, streetlighting, bollards and road signage. This work will start on 26 Nov 18 and complete during Spring 2019.

To facilitate these works it will be necessary to have two-way traffic lights on the Packway for the duration of the works. The north end of Bingham Road will be closed while these traffic lights are operational. We apologise for any inconvenience that this will cause.

These traffic lights will not be in place over the Christmas period (21 Dec 18 – 8 Jan 19).

Future Works

Further road works will be required in 2019 to repair the kerbs of the Packway from the Packway/School Road roundabout heading East towards Stonehenge Inn Roundabout and to carry out resurfacing works to the Packway from the Packway/School Road roundabout heading both East and West. Future travel notices will give further information regarding dates and traffic control while these works are undertaken.
