For the past 18 months the Youth Club has been operating out of Bulford Village Hall on a Thursday evening due to lack of suitable and available facilities in Durrington. Starting this September, the Youth Club will set up its new home in the Jubilee Pavilion on the Recreation Ground. We have a small team of staff and regular volunteers to help with the three sessions; Street Based (Tuesdays from 7-9pm, with a drop in at the Pavilion from 8pm for refreshments), Youth Club (years 7-19 years old) on a Thursday (7-9pm) and Kids' Friday Club (ages 7-11) on a Friday evening at the Pavilion (6-7.30pm).
